Home Worship Kits

Contact the church office to get yours!

During this time of continued caution concerning the ongoing pandemic, many people are not feeling very comfortable coming to worship on Sunday mornings. We understand that feeling and that is why we have created a "Home Worship Kit." A Home Worship Kit certainly doesn't take the place of worshiping together in our church building (and you are always welcome), but worship comes in many forms and we hope you find this a helpful tool to draw you closer to God.

Inside this kit you will find prayers, scriptures, a battery powered candle, a wooden cross (*made by Lynette Saltzman*), and even a brief printed liturgy for a form of holy communion appropriate for individuals and families.

You are invited to use this kit to create a sacred space in your home for worship, devotions, or just a quiet time alone with God. Use all of it, or just part of it. You may also want to add some of the following to enhance your time with God:

- *a cloth/scarf on which you can place your items.
- *a Bible and possibly a hymnal/book of songs that have sacred meaning to you
- * a small rock or stone (or several) to remind you that Christ is your rock.
- * any item that has sacred meaning to you.
- *invite the children in your household to contribute items to your sacred home worship space.

Thank you to all who volunteered this month to help with the distribution; we could not do it without you all!






Little Free Pantry
