
## **Enhanced Online Giving**



All adults over the age of 16 are now eligible for the vaccine. To schedule an appointment with the County please contact the CCHD at 785-243-8140. Vaccines are also available at local pharmacies: <u>Auburn Pharmacy</u>, <u>Funk Pharmacy</u>, <u>Panther Pride Pharmacy</u>, and <u>Walmart</u>.
